

STANDING ORDER


It appearing to the Court that it would be beneficial to child victims to receive compensation from the North Dakota Crime Victims Compensation Program for their losses as victims of federal crimes or alleged federal crimes; it is hereby

ORDERED that the United States Attorney's Office and federal law enforcement agencies may disclose necessary information concerning a child who is the victim of an alleged federal crime to the North Dakota Crime Victims Compensation Program, and that Program's agents and employees, to facilitate the North Dakota Crime Victims Compensation Program in processing and considering for reimbursement a federal child victim's claim. This disclosure, in the opinion of the Court, is necessary for the welfare and well being of the child and is allowed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3509(d)(4).
