	Original	First Copy to Each Party	Each Add'l Copy to the Same Party
<b>Ordinary Transcript (30 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$3.65	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>14-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.25	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>Expedited Transcript (7 day)</b> A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.85	\$ .90	\$ .60
<b>Daily Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered following adjournment and prior to the normal opening hour of the court on the following morning whether or not it actually is a court day.	\$6.05	\$1.20	\$ .90
<b>Hourly Transcript</b> A transcript of proceedings ordered under unusual circumstances to be delivered within two (2) hours.	\$7.25	\$1.20	\$ .90
<b>Realtime Transcript</b> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following adjournment.	\$3.05	\$1.20
