This matter having come before the Court on the application by the United States Attorney's Office for the District of North Dakota for an Order authorizing the United States Federal Air Marshal Service (FAMS) to issue citations for violations of certain sections of the United States Code, and for good cause appearing therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that FAMS is now authorized to issue citations or violation notices to any person whom they have probable cause to believe is guilty of violations occurring in the District of North Dakota of the specifically enumerated offenses set forth in Exhibit A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the proposed bail schedule and forfeiture of collateral schedule for the enumerated offenses are approved by the Court as set forth in Exhibit A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that FAMS may use the location code designated by The Central Violations Bureau (CVB) for the District of North Dakota, with respect to violations of the enumerated offenses as set forth in Exhibit A that occur within the District of North Dakota.
