EVoucher Software Upgrade May 11-12, 2024

Effective Monday, May 13, a new login procedure for eVoucher is required. Each attorney will be required to set up an individual Login.gov account. Login.gov requires multi-factor authentication. Login.gov is the first step of the transition to receiving CJA payments via electronic funds transfer. Please review the information below before the next time you login to eVoucher.

To create a Login.gov account, photos of the attorney's driver's license or State ID and their social security number are required for identity verification.
